

Academic Coaching@LN is an after-school program offered to all students in Year 9-12.

The program operates weekly from Monday to Thursday, 3:30pm until 5:15pm during Term time. Students can choose to participate in one or more days of the program.

The Academic Coaching program offers students the opportunity to work in groups of 5-6 students, with a subject matter expert in Year 9-12 English & Mathematics.

The Academic Coaches are qualified teachers or current university students who have proven expertise in the requisite subject matter.

Afternoon tea is included in the \$60 daily charge and is served from 3:15pm. Students may change into more comfortable clothing at this time. The Academic Coaching program runs from 3:30pm with student dismissal at 5:15pm.



What is the cost of the Program?

The program is \$60 per day and includes afternoon tea. This is billed to student accounts in the following term. Enrolment is for an entire term.

How will Academic Coaching @LN be staffed?

The program is overseen by teaching staff and current university students who have proven expertise in the requisite subject matter area.

Where does the program take place?

The program will take place in the Loreto Normanhurst Secondary School classrooms.

When does the program take place?

This program will take place after school from Monday - Wednesday. Please note this schedule is subject to sufficient interest.

Will the coaching be tailored to my daughter's skill level and academic ability?

We will endeavour to tailor the composition of the student groups based on the course that your daughter is enrolled in at school (e.g. 5.2 or 5.3 Mathematics or Stage 6 Standard/Advanced English or Mathematics).



What will be the nature of the work provided?

The work provided will focus on skill development and the acquisition of requisite skills, rather than the delivery of content. The sessions will not be utilised for assessment task preparation or the completion of homework.

Will the program accommodate my daughter's extra-curricular commitments?

Students are advised to factor in their extra-curricular commitments before committing to the Academic Coaching sessions as they will not be accommodated in this program.

Does my daughter need to wear her school uniform?

Students may choose to bring a change of clothing for the afternoon.

Will my daughter need to attend every afternoon or every week? Parents select the subject areas and day(s) of the week on which their daughter will attend. Enrolment is for a whole term so you will be charged regardless of your

daughter's attendance.

What if my daughter needs to leave the session before the 5.15pm conclusion? She may do so, however families are invoiced for the full cost of the program for each afternoon

If my daughter is absent, will I still be charged? Are make-up days available?

regardless of the pick-up time.

Your account will be charged for a whole term – attendance is not taken into consideration. At this stage, make-up days are not available. However, if you know in advance and would like to swap a day, this may be accommodated as long as ample prior notice is provided.

What happens if a public holiday falls on my daughter's Academic Coaching @LN day?

Academic Coaching@LN will not operate on a non-school day, and you will not be billed for that afternoon. The total cost for the term will take into account public holidays or pupil free days falling within the term. Any absence due to school camps or other school business will be taken into consideration. These days will not be charged.
